

CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS AFTER CHILE QUALIFER A REBUILDING AND REINVENTING PROCESS

March 10	India fails to qualify for the Beijing Olympics, coach Carvalho resigns
March 11	Public anger on large scale, media take up hockey seriously, politicians pitch in to demand KPS Gill's resignation.
March 11	Most former Olympians want Joaquim him to continue as Chief coach.
March 1	KPS Gill seeks 2 more years to set things right in a television interview
March 1	The IOA defends IHF in a press conference in Delhi
March 19	Many Olympians including Balbir Singh Sr., MP Ganesh, Zafar Iqbal visit KPS Gill's residence to extend support to KPS Gill.
March 20	KPS Gill forms a new Selection Committee with MP Ganesh as its chief
March 21	Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports sign a belated contract with Richard Charlesworth
March 21	KPS Gill rejects Carvalho's resignation, refuses to accommodate Charlesworth, hold an informal EC Meeting at his residence.
April 7	MS Gill replaces Mani Shankar Aiyar as the Union Sports Minister
April 18	Joaquim Carvalho takes a team for an Australia tour
April 21:	Aajtak television broadcasts a sting operation, involving IHF Secretary taking bribe. The Secretary resigns, files a libel suit in court.
April 22	KPS Gill announces Inquiry Panel to probe the sting
April 23	MS Gill places hockey back into the priority list of the government
April 27	FIH President gives a strong interview in Kazan against Gill and Jothi; PTI flashes it on national scale
April 28	IOA dissolves the IHF and announces new Selection Committee with Aslam Sher Khan as its Chairman. KPS Gill moves court.
May 6	IOA's Ad-hoc Hockey Committee announced with its president Suresh Kalmadi as Chairman, Md. Aslam as convener.
May 18	India wins silver at the Azlan Cup, Sandeep Singh returns to the side.
May 12	Outgoing IHF manages to cancel Indian junior team's Poland tour
May 26	Asian Hockey Federation allows the Ad-hoc Committee to organize the Junior Asia Cup.
June 17	The FIH confirms allotment of 2010 World Cup to India. AHF's Executive Committee Meeting held in Hyderabad. KPS Gill attends.
June 18	India successfully defends the Junior Asia Cup in Hyderabad.
July	Ajit Pal replaces Aslam Sher Khan as Selection Committee Chairman. Four coaches sent to Beijing Olympics as observers.
August	Bengal Hockey Association organizes a seminar at Ambey Valley.
August	The FIH and the IOA sign MOU in Beijing to conduct 2010 World Cup.
September 17	Selection Committee announces MK Kaushik as Men's Chief coach; probabilities for national camp announced.
September 17	KPS Gill convenes 'AGM' in Delhi with thin attendance.
September 27	Harendera chief coach, as MK Kaushik stays with women's team.
October	Both first phase of Junior and Senior camps start respectively at Bhopal and Bangalore.
November	Govt. of India called off Jr. team's Pakistan Series in the eleventh hour
